### **Notes**

1. In the event of a Jersey vessel, not being a pleasure vessel, being lost, presumed lost or abandoned, article 169 of the Shipping (Jersey) Law 2002 imposes a duty on the owner, master or senior surviving officer to submit a report to the Minister as soon as practicable by the quickest means available. In any other event, the master shall send the report not less than 24 hours after the ship next arrives in port.

2. Regarding pleasure vessels, information is to be submitted on request.

3. An owner, master or officer who, without reasonable excuse, fails to submit this report is liable to a fine up to £5,000.
