**Diseases of Animals (Rabies) (Importation of Mammals) (Jersey) Order 2011,
EU Legislation (Veterinary and Zootechnical Checks – Trade with Member States) (Jersey) Regulations 2016,**

Application for a licence to import commercial animals* : dogs, cats and ferrets specified in Part 2 of the Schedule of the Diseases of Animals (Rabies) (Importation of Mammals) (Jersey) Order 2011.

Pet dogs, cats and ferrets which are imported solely under the Pet Travel Scheme (Jersey) Regulation 2011 do not require a licence but must have either a valid Pet Passport, an Animal Health Certificate or a Great Britain Pet Health Certificate.

*Dogs, cats and ferrets that are being imported for sale or re-homing which therefore involves a transfer of ownership are commercial movements.

Please allow 10 working days for the application process. The licence will be valid for one month from the date of issue

Conditions to this Licence:

- 1. The animal(s) shall be landed on or within one calendar month** (unless otherwise indicated) **from the date of issue of the licence.**
- If consigned by air the container or crate must be escape proof, nose and paw proof and meet the appropriate International Air Transport Association (IATA) standards.
- The animals are from a holding or business registered with the EU Member State of origin;
- The dogs and cats must satisfy the requirements set out in Regulation (EU) No 576/2013.
 - They must be identified by a transponder (microchip) prior to vaccination;
 - At the time of rabies vaccination the animal(s) must be at least 12 weeks old;
 - After vaccination wait for a minimum of 21 days (the day the vaccination is given is day zero);
 - In the case of dogs (other than those from Ireland, Finland, Norway or Malta) be treated for echinococcus (tapeworm) not less than 24 hours and not more than 120 hours (5 days) prior to arrival in Jersey;
- Be accompanied by an original health certificate signed by an authorised veterinarian. The model certificate for entry to the GB and the Crown Dependencies is [here](#). A copy can be supplied on request: and
- A certified copy of the identification and vaccination details of the animals concerned shall be attached to the certificate.”
- The Transporter will transport the animals in accordance with the provisions of Council Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005.
- The importer must send a copy of the signed health certificate to Natural Environment at that should be least 24 hours prior to import. Email address: Pets@gov.je
- The importer must give 1 working day notice of the actual date of import by contacting Natural Environment and using the notification form provided (a copy can be obtained from Natural Environment. Email address: Pets@gov.je
- The dogs and cats shall be landed at the Port of St Helier or the Airport, St Peter.

Any licence, permit or authorization granted under this Order may be revoked, suspended or varied at any time by the Minister or a person authorized to do so on behalf of the Minister.
