Q WE ASKED FOR YOUR COMMENTS RELATING TO THESE AREAS OF TRAINING, HERE'S WHAT YOU SAID...

51 comments refer to the need for industry/job specific training, including:

- 19 comments refer to customer facing roles such as hospitality, retail and healthcare roles
- 13 comments refer to construction, manufacturing, electrical and decorating
- 6 comments refer to IT, digital and telecommunications
- 5 comments refer to farming, ecology and arboriculture
- 4 comments refer to financial services including 3 requests for compliance
- 4 comments refer to vets and animal welfare
- 3 comments refer to first aid
- 3 comments refer to safeguarding

10 comments requested various management training including leadership/team management, middle and senior management, financial management and warehouse / site management

6 comments referred to IT skills, with 3 comments emphasising the need for coding and development training, and a further 4 comments requested Excel training.

WE ASKED FOR YOUR IDEAS ABOUT SKILLS TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES THAT WOULD HELP REDUCE RELIANCE ON REGISTERED PERMISSIONS, HERE'S WHAT YOU SAID...

10 comments referred to industries promoting their opportunities through links with schools and colleges, the continued importance of work placements and the need to change perceptions of the industry within the locally qualified population

7 comments referred to the need for more people undertaking apprenticeships, more degree level apprenticeships and exchanges between trainee staff in Jersey and other countries to develop skills and experience

7 comments identified the need for specialist training, the importance of accessing training in the UK / bringing in UK trainers to Jersey and working more closely with each sector to identify their skills gaps

4 comments suggested a need to change the migration system or that there was not a need to reduce reliance on registered staffing permissions

2 comments suggested reducing the tax and social security contributions for lower paid staff and giving registered staff the opportunity to access training in the care sector
