Lived experiences of termination of pregnancy in Jersey

Quotation for services from the Centre for Reproductive Research & Communication 26 April 2023

BACKGROUND

The Centre for Reproductive Research & Communication (CRRC) is submitting this quotation in response to a request from the Government of Jersey (GoJ) to provide research consultancy services for a project on the lived experiences of termination of pregnancy (TOP). This work will be used to inform an upcoming public consultation on abortion legislation in Jersey.

Established in 2019, the CRRC exists to develop and deliver research that furthers access to evidence-based reproductive healthcare and inform policy, practice, and public discourse. We are situated within the British Pregnancy Advisory Service which is a charity in England that provides pregnancy counselling, abortion, contraception testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections, and vasectomy. The CRRC draws on BPAS' activities to inform our research agenda and we work in collaboration and through strategic partnerships to achieve our mission. All members of the research team have extensive experience in abortion-related research and good research practice. The CRRC is overseen by an expert Steering Committee (details here). Please also see the reference list for recently published relevant research from the CRRC team (full text available on request).

DESCRIPTION OF APPROACH AND METHODS

Objectives

To gather the experiences of those who have:

- a) Had a TOP in Jersey
- b) Engaged with the formal healthcare system about having a TOP in Jersey
- Travelled from Jersey to have a TOP overseas.

The objectives can be refined further with input from both CRRC and GoJ staff.

Participant selection and recruitment

It is noted in the request for quotation that the GoJ officers will carry out recruitment and administration related to interviews. We will work with the local team in Jersey to advise on best practice for recruitment for abortion-related research. We will also work with the agencies in Jersey thorough which patients are referred and who provide abortion care if needed to inform a recruitment and selection strategy. We will also advise on an appropriate number of participants depending on the final objectives. It may be possible to recruit participants who obtained abortion pills through the informal sector. This would need further discussion with the GoJ team.

Data collection

Semi-structured interview guides will be used to explore the research objectives whilst affording the interviewer flexibility to skip questions already answered and probe in more detail where needed.



Interviews may be conducted face-to-face or via telephone/online conference call. In our experience many qualitative study participants in abortion-related research prefer a remote interview modality but we will also travel to Jersey for face-to-face ones. Informed consent will be sought from all participants before proceeding with an interview. Interviews will be audio recorded and transcribed by a professional transcription service. All participants will also be offered the opportunity to choose a pseudonym and any identifiable information from their interviews will be redacted.

We will work with the team in the GoJ to co-produce the interview guide to ensure that the information acquired meets their aims and objectives. We will draw on our extensive experience in working with those who have had an abortion to ensure that the interview process does not stigmatise participants and is sensitive to their experiences.

Data analysis and report writing

We will conduct reflexive thematic analysis (1,2). This involves several steps including data familiarisation, coding using an inductive framework (generated from the data itself) and writing summaries of data pertaining to each code. These summaries are then discussed amongst the research team for interpretation, who then develop high level themes from the data. We are familiar with this approach and have recently published several peer-reviewed papers using this methodology (3–6).

We will write up our findings into a report for the GoJ and draw on our expertise as abortion providers and researchers to make recommendations to improve provision of abortion in Jersey. While we may use direct quotations in the report, we will not utilise any identifying information.

Our approach to preventing harm

We acknowledge that abortion is a sensitive subject. Participants who experienced difficulties in accessing abortion care or who had a particularly stigmatising experience may feel distressed by participating in interviews. We have extensive experience of interviewing participants about their abortion and other reproductive health issues and will ensure all participants have access to short-and longer-term support if they need it. This includes a thorough informed consent process, pastoral support during the interview if they become upset (e.g., pausing the interview, offering tissues, active listening), and support in accessing support through organisations such as Abortion Talk.

Whilst abortion is often a stigmatised experience, it is very common healthcare need. Data from Jersey from 2020 observed a rate of 9.1 per 1000 woman aged 15-44 years. It is important to recognise that whilst some participants may need some support, those who have had an abortion are not inherently vulnerable by virtue of having one. We will ensure those who need support are able to access it, but that others are not stigmatised or made to feel that they should have negative feelings about their abortion, as it is paramount that participants are not stigmatised through participation in the research itself.

PROJECT PLAN

Given the nature of the in-depth work required, we advise extending the project to August. If the July deadline outlined in the request for quotation is hard and fast, we can adjust the project plan accordingly, but this may have a bearing on sample size as data from a larger sample will take longer to analyse.

Rebecca was lead researcher on WRISK, a research-engagement project funded by the Wellcome Trust which aimed to improve our understanding of the way that pregnancy-related risk is communicated.

Rebecca is an Associate Editor for the journal BMJ Sexual and Reproductive Health. She was recently awarded a prestigious NIHR/Wellbeing of Women Doctoral Fellowship to study how the introduction of telemedicine has impacted the accessibility and equity of abortion in England and Wales. She starts the fellowship at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine in September 2023.

Rebecca has recently acted as an expert consultant on qualitative abortion research for the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RCOG) and Ibis Reproductive Health and has experience of delivering consultancy projects on time and within budget. She is experienced in conducting qualitative research with patients on their experiences of abortion, and other sensitive issues such as miscarriage and stillbirth, and mental health issues in pregnancy. She has conducted nearly 100
