An **Easy Read** guide about finding out if you have a Learning Disability and your screening appointment.





Your screening appointment

	<p>We work in the Learning Disability team.</p> <p>We want to find out if our team can help you.</p>
	<p>We have been asked to meet with you to see if you have a Learning Disability.</p> <p>This is called screening.</p>
	<p>You will need to have an assessment.</p> <p>An assessment means we will ask you some questions so we can find out more about you.</p>

What happens next

	<p>The letter will say if you have a Learning Disability or not.</p> <p>We will then ask to see you.</p> <p>We will talk to you about what will happen next.</p>
	<p>If you do have a Learning Disability then our team will be able to help you.</p>
	<p>If you do not have a Learning Disability another team might be able to help you.</p>
	<p>We look forward to meeting you!</p>




Your screening report

	<p>We will be making notes this helps us remember things you said.</p>
	<p>The notes will be written up into a report.</p> <p>Only other people in the Learning Disability Team will be able to see the report.</p> <p>This is so they can help you too.</p>
	<p>If there is anything you don't want people to know please tell us and we can talk about it.</p>
	<p>Once the report is ready, we will write you a letter.</p>


Your screening appointment

	<p>We can see you at Eagle House or we can visit you in your home.</p>
	<p>It is helpful to have someone with you who can help answer these questions.</p>
	<p>You can bring a family member or one of your Support staff who has known you for a long time.</p>

Your screening appointment

	<p>We can ask to speak with someone on the telephone if they cannot come to the appointment with you.</p>
	<p>At your appointment we will ask you some questions about your past.</p>
	<p>We will ask about your childhood and when you went to school.</p>

Your screening appointment

	<p>We will ask about things you find easy or difficult to do now.</p>
	<p>We will ask you about your life and how you feel.</p>
	<p>We will ask you about things you enjoy.</p>
<p>1 hour</p> 	<p>The Assessment will take around 1 hour.</p>
	<p>We might need to see you again on a different day to ask more questions.</p>
