States Employment Boad – Appointment of Executive Members 5 February 2024

Background

Article 5 of the Employment of States of Jersey Employees (Jersey) Law 2005 ("the Law") concerns the membership of the States Employment Board (see Appendix A). Following the appointment of the Chief Minister on 30 January 2024, a reconstitution of the States Employment Board ("SEB") is required in accordance with Article 5(1)(a) - (c) of the Law.

Appointments

The Chief Minister made the following executive appointments to the SEB:

- 1. Deputy M. R. Ferey of St. Saviour, Assistant Minister to the Chief Minister
- 2. Deputy R. Binet of Grouville and St. Martin, Assistant Minister to the Chief Minister

Appendix A

5 Membership of States Employment Board

- The States Employment Board shall be constituted by
 - the Chief Minister, or another Minister who is nominated by the Chief Minister to be a member of the Board in his or her place;
 - (b) 2 other persons, each of whom
 - (i) is a Minister or an Assistant Minister, and
 - is appointed in writing by the Chief Minister to be a member of the Board; and
 - (c) 2 elected members of the States, each of whom -
 - (i) is neither a Minister nor an Assistant Minister, and
 - (ii) is elected by the States to be a member of the Board.⁸
- (2) The Chief Minister or, if the Chief Minister nominates a person under paragraph (1) to be a member of the Board in his or her place, that person, shall be the Chairman of the States Employment Board.
- (3) A member of the States Employment Board shall hold office until a Chief Minister is appointed to office, under Article 19(7) of the <u>States of Jersey Law 2005</u>, following the next ordinary election, unless the member of the Board resigns or is removed from office earlier.⁹
