## EDUCATION (DISCRETIONARY GRANTS) (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) ORDER 2006

*Made*

*12th June 2006*

*Coming into force*

*19th June 2006*

**THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION, SPORT AND CULTURE**, in pursuance of Articles 51 and 68 of the Education (Jersey) Law 1999<sup>1</sup>, orders as follows –

### **1 Article 17A inserted**

After Article 17 of the Education (Discretionary Grants) (Jersey) Order 2005<sup>2</sup> there shall be inserted the following Article –

#### **“17A Saving if Schedule provision or amount is changed**

(1) If –

- (a) an enactment amends this Order by deleting a provision in a Schedule, or a monetary amount in a provision of a Schedule, and the enactment is expressed to apply in respect of one or more academic years and that year is, or those years are, subsequent to the academic year current at the date when the enactment takes effect; or
- (b) an enactment amends this Order by inserting (by substitution or otherwise) a provision in a Schedule or a monetary amount in a provision of a Schedule, and the enactment, or either of the provisions, is expressed to apply in respect of one or more academic years and that year is, or those years are, subsequent to the academic year current at the date when the enactment takes effect,

the amendment shall not affect the operation of the Schedule, as in force immediately before that date, in relation to the remainder of the academic year in which that date falls.

(2) Paragraph (1) shall be subject to any express provision to the contrary.”.

**2 Schedule 2 amended**

For paragraph 6(3) of Schedule 2 to the Education (Discretionary Grants) (Jersey) Order 2005 there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph –

“(3) The maximum contribution in respect of each award of standard student grant shall be £11,711 for the academic year beginning on 1st September 2006, and for each of the following academic years.”.

**3 Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Education (Discretionary Grants) (Amendment) (Jersey) Order 2006 and shall come into force 7 days after it is made.
