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Introduction

The Minister for Economic Development, Tourism, Sport and Culture is set to appoint new Commissioners to the Gambling Commission in 2024 at the conclusion of the terms of the current Board. The Minister, at the request of the Chairman of the Commission, decided to extend the term of Commissioner Debbie Sebire by two years and Appointment Dr Jason Lane to the Commission to allow for an 18-month hand-over period for the new Board.

Detail

Commissioner Sebire is currently set to retire on 2nd November 2023 following eight years of service. The Minister decided to extend this term by a further two years to allow for a handover period with the new Board during 2024.

Additionally, at the request of the Chairman of the Commission, decided to appoint Dr Lane, Chief Executive of the Commission, as a Commissioner. In accordance with Article 3(3), of the <u>Gambling Commission (Jersey) Law 2010</u> the Chief Executive is to continue to be renumerated as an employee of the Commission rather than as a Commissioner. Additionally, in accordance with Article 4(3)e the term of office for this appointment is to cover the period of the Chief Executive's employment with the Commission.
