THE MINISTER FOR ECONOMIC DEVEOPMENT, in pursuance of Regulation 7 of the Sea Fisheries (Licensing of Fishing Boats) (Jersey) Regulations 2003, Regulation 3 of the Sea Fisheries (Underwater Fishing) (Jersey) Regulations 2003, Regulations 2 and 5 of the Sea Fisheries (Fisheries) (Jersey) Regulations 2010, Articles 193 and 196 of the Shipping (Jersey) Law 2002, Articles 12 and 38 of the Weights and Measures (Jersey) Law 1967, Articles 9 and 32 of the Tourism (Jersey) Law 1948, and Articles 4 and 14 of the Places of Refreshment (Jersey) Law 1967, and orders as follows –

1 Sea Fisheries (General Fees) (Jersey) Order 2010 amended
