

Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) Survey - Field H1552 & H1551

Description of works:

We would like to carry out a survey to obtain information from below the ground to determine if there are any unexploded ordnance in the field denoting in Fig. 01 below. The process to gather this information is by scanning and probing the terrain to assess if there are unexploded ordnance embedded in the ground – this is to ensure any planned ground works can be carried out safely and with the minimum amount of risk.

Plant and Equipment:

A ground penetrating radar capable of detecting ordnance up to 5 metres in depth.

Duration:

We would like to start the survey in field H 1552 & H 1551 on 07/06/2021 for approx. 1 week.

The proposed survey working times are between 08:00AM and 17:00PM Monday to Friday.

No works will be undertaken on Saturdays and Sundays
