Introduction

The Minster was contacted by the applicants regarding a property they own called La Rochelle, La Grande Route de la Cote, St Clement.

The applicants would like to demolish the existing house and redevelop the site to construct a new dwelling for themselves and their son.

A request for pre-application advice was first submitted in 2021. A planning application was submitted in February 2022, the scheme was revised during its consideration but subsequently refused in June 2022.

Further pre-application advice was sought, and provided, and a revised planning application submitted in June 2023. The application validated in September 2023, and subsequently refused on 11 March 2024.

Further pre-application advice was sought in July 2024, and this was provided in a face to face meeting in August and then in writing in September 2024. At that time, the period in which a "free go" could be submitted (6 months) had just expired and the case officer advised the agent of this fact.

The Minister was asked to consider whether a waiver of the application fee in the amount of approximately £6,518.20 would be given.

The Minister may waive all or part of a fee for a planning application pursuant to Article 5 of the Planning and Building (Fees)(Jersey) Order 2008.

Recommendation

Recommendation to reject the application for a refund of the application fee.

Decision

The Minister has decided to reject the application for the refund of planning application fees pursuant to Article 5 of the Planning and Building (Fees)(Jersey) Order 2008.

Reason for decision

The Minister's decision aligns with previous such requests and is consistent with his approach of only applying fee waivers of 50% for Jersey registered charities.
