Detail

Following an appeal against the refusal of planning permission on land at Verte Vue Farm, La Rue du Rondin, St Mary (P/2023/1259), DA Hainsworth was appointed as the independent planning inspector to consider the appeal, including all plans and documentation associated with it.

The inspector visited the site and surroundings before holding a hearing and, subsequently, preparing and submitting a report for the Minister's consideration.

The Minister has given full consideration to the inspector's report and to the material factors referred to in it.

Decision

The Minister decided to allow the appeal and to grant planning permission, in accord with the inspector's recommendation, for development for the purpose of cultivation of plants of the genus Cannabis, and the preparation for distribution comprising the drying of plants and packaging; works to alter and extend existing agricultural building, erect perimeter fencing, create ancillary parking area, associated landscaping and upgrade and amend existing access road at Verte Vue Farm, La Rue du Rondin, St Mary in accordance with the application P/2023/1259 dated 15 December 2023 and the plans and documents submitted therewith, subject to those conditions recommended by the inspector and set out in the schedule appended to this written report:

Reason for decision

Having considered all aspects of the appeal the Minister decided to give effect to the inspector's recommendation and was satisfied that there were no reasons not to do so.
