### Introduction

A complaint was sent to the Minister by a Planning Agent (PA) regarding unsatisfactory treatment that he and his client have received from the Directorate about a submitted planning application. The complaint focuses on the issue that the Case Officer's assessment of the proposal has been delayed by the intervention of a Senior Planning Officer who required additional information prior to determination. This information was provided, and the application was subsequently determined favourably. The PA requested that, in the circumstances, the Minister consider whether a refund of the application fee in the amount of £6,465.01 would be given.

The Minister may waive all or part of a fee for a planning application pursuant to Article 5 of the Planning and Building (Fees)(Jersey) Order 2008.

The Minister for the Environment decided to rescind the previous decision MD-ENV-2025-225 dated 26/03/25025 which incorrectly states that there are new financial and/or staffing implications. In this decision the Minister for the Environment decided to reject the application for a refund of the application fee. The Minister has therefore decided to reissue the MD, with the corrections made.

### Recommendation

Recommendation to rescind the previous MD-ENV-2025-225 and re-issuing the MD, stating that the decision regarding the application fee stands, and there are no resourcing implications.

### Decision

The Minister has decided to reject the application for the refund of planning application fees pursuant to Art.5 of the Planning and Building (Fees)(Jersey) Order 2008 and re-issue the MD to make corrections to the previously issued MD-ENV-2025-225.

### Reason for decision

The Minister's decision aligns with previous such requests and is consistent with his approach of only applying fee waivers of 50% for Jersey registered charities and changes the previous error in MD-ENV-2025-225 which incorrectly stated that there were resourcing implications.
