EU LEGISLATION (SANCTIONS – YEMEN) (JERSEY) ORDER 2014

Made

Coming into force

THE MINISTER FOR EXTERNAL RELATIONS, in pursuance of Article 2 of the European Union Legislation (Implementation) (Jersey) Law 2014, orders as follows –

1 Interpretation

In this Order –

"General Provisions Order" means the EU Legislation (Sanctions) (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 2014;

"implemented Regulation" means Council Regulation (EU) No 1352/2014 of 18 December 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen (OJ L 365, 19.12.2014, p. 60).

2 Ambulatory references to Annexes

In the implemented Regulation as it has effect in Jersey by virtue of Article 4, a reference to an Annex to that Regulation is to be read as a reference to that Annex -

- (a) as amended, substituted, extended or applied from time to time by any other EU provision; or
- (b) as it otherwise has effect in the EU from time to time by virtue of any judgment of the European Court.

3 Application of general provisions to implemented Regulation

- (1) This Order is a relevant special Order for the purpose of the General Provisions Order.
- (2) All the general provisions of the General Provisions Order are to be read as part of this Order, and the implemented Regulation is the relevant EU provision for the purpose of those general provisions when they are so read.

4 EU Regulation implemented

The implemented Regulation has effect as if it were an enactment -

- (a) to any extent that it does not otherwise have effect in Jersey; and
- (b) subject to the modifications made by the general provisions that are to be read as part of this Order by virtue of Article 3(2).

5 Offences

- (1) A person who
 - (a) contravenes Article 2 or 10 of the implemented Regulation as it has effect in Jersey by virtue of Article 4;
 - (b) intentionally furnishes false information or a false explanation to any person exercising powers under Article 10 of the General Provisions Order when read as part of this Order; or
 - (c) with intent to evade the provisions of Article 10 of the General Provisions Order, destroys, mutilates, defaces, secretes or removes any document,

is guilty of an offence and liable to imprisonment for a term of 2 years and to a fine.

- (2) A person who, without reasonable excuse, contravenes
 - (a) Article 10(3) of the General Provisions Order when read as part of this Order; or
 - (b) Article 9 of the implemented Regulation as it has effect in Jersey by virtue of Article 4,

is guilty of an offence and liable to imprisonment for a term of 3 months and to a fine.

6 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the EU Legislation (Sanctions – Yemen) (Jersey) Order 2014 and shall come into force on the day after the day on which it is made.
