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## **LONG-TERM CARE SERVICES (HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES CHARGES) (JERSEY) ORDER 2014**

**THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES**, after consultation with the Minister for Social Security and in pursuance of Article 2 of the Long-Term Care (Health and Social Services Charges) (Jersey) Law 2014, orders as follows –

### **1 Interpretation**

In this Order “care home” and “group home” have the same meaning as in the Long-Term Care (Benefits) (Jersey) Order 2014.

### **2 Charges for long-term care services**

Where long-term care services are provided to a person aged 18 years or over in a care home or a group home of a level and description specified in columns 1 and 2 of the table, the Minister shall make and recover from the person a charge for the provision of those services of the amount specified opposite such level and description in –

- (a) column 3, if the person is in a care home, for each week that such services are provided;
- (b) column 4, if the person is in a care home, for each day during any period less than a week in which such services are provided;
- (c) column 5, if the person is in a group home, for each week that such services are provided;
- (d) column 6, if the person is in a group home, for each day during any period less than a week in which such services are provided.

1	Person requires long-term care services on a daily basis but can be left alone for periods of at least 3 hours a day.	£665.91	£95.13	£914.62	£130.66

### 3 Circumstances in which charges do not apply

The Minister shall not make and recover a charge from a person under Article 2 if the person is –

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- (a) detained in a care home or group home under Article 6 or 7 of the Mental Health (Jersey) Law 1969; or
  - (b) received into guardianship and required by the Minister to reside in such a home pursuant to Article 16 of that Law.

**4 Long-Term Care (Health and Social Services Charges) (Jersey) Order 2014 revoked**

The Long-Term Care (Health and Social Services Charges) (Jersey) Order 2014 is revoked.

**5 Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Long-Term Care Services (Health and Social Services Charges) (Jersey) Order 2014 and shall come into force on the same date that Parts 3 and 4 of the Long-Term Care (Jersey) Law 2014 come into force.
