Introduction

E J Bailhache Fund

The late E J Bailhache bequeathed assets for the following purposes, as detailed in her Will dated 20th September 1974, to be used by the "Public of the Island of Jersey for the benefit of the Public Health Committee (now the Minister for Health and Social Services) of the States of Jersey, for the general welfare of persons elderly, and/or blind or sick at the General Hospital.

The E J Bailhache Fund is overseen by a government-wide Charitable Funds Oversight Board, which provides an independent assurance function for all charitable trust funds.

Applications for funding from E J Bailhache Fund are administered and presented to the Minister for Health and Social Services by Health and Care Jersey. The decisions taken and rationale must be documented in a Ministerial Decision.

Reason for the Decision

The video laryngoscope will enable Less Invasive Surfactant Administration (LISA) of surfactant to a gold standard and will provide an additional option for treating a difficult airway situation in neonates.

The application complies with the criteria for grant funding from the E J Bailhache Fund because the new equipment will enhance the service currently available to patients receiving treatment at the Jersey General Hospital.

Financial resources for maintaining the new equipment can be met from existing budgets.

The Minister is recommended to approve £26,496 to be taken from the E J Bailhache Fund to support this application.
