Christians Together in Jersey (CTJ) Housing Trust: Nomination of a Trustee

Purpose of the report

The Minister for Housing and Communities (the 'Minister') wishes to approve an appointment of a new trustee for Christians Together in Jersey (CTJ) Housing Trust.

Background

The constitution of the CTJ Housing Trust states that the Minister for Housing and Communities must approve the appointment of any new trustee. The board of trustees have recommended the appointment of Lorraine Wheeler, following the stepping down of the current post holder. Having recently retired after 38 years in the trust industry, Lorraine is a trustee for the Methodist Church, overseeing properties held on their behalf. She is also currently studying to be a Presbyterian in the Methodist Church and has been involved with the rehabilitation of ex-prisoners, which aligns well with the housing trust's provision of accommodation for ex-inmates of La Moye.

Recommendation

The Minister for Housing and Communities recommends approving the appointment of Lorraine Wheeler as trustee of the Christians Together in Jersey (CTJ) Housing Trust. Lorraine Wheeler will replace a previous trustee who has retired due to ill health.
