SAND RACING (No. 2) (JERSEY) ORDER 2006

*Made**13th October 2006**Coming into force**20th October 2006*

THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND TECHNICAL SERVICES, in pursuance of Article 2(2) of the Motor Vehicle Races (Jersey) Law 1946¹, on the application of the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club and after consultation with the Minister for Economic Development, orders as follows –

1 Interpretation

In this Order –

“course” means a part of the beach in St. Aubin’s Bay, to be determined by the promoters, within the area bounded –

- (a) on the north by the sea wall;
- (b) on the east by an imaginary line running from north-east to south-west and intersecting the slipway at West Park;
- (c) on the south by the sea; and
- (d) on the west by an imaginary line –
 - (i) running parallel to and at a distance of 650 metres to the west of the line specified in paragraph (b), and
 - (ii) intersecting the groyne on the sea wall opposite Bay View Court;

“promoters” means the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club.

2 Use of part of St. Aubin’s Bay for sand racing

Subject to the Sand Racing (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 1959², on 28th October 2006 between 5 p.m. and 8 p.m. the promoters may –

- (a) use the course for races, and practices for races, with motor vehicles; and
- (b) for those purposes close the course.

3 Citation

This Order may be cited as the Sand Racing (No. 2) (Jersey) Order 2006 and shall come into force 7 days after it is made.
