ROAD RACING (MOTOR VEHICLE RALLY) (JERSEY) ORDER 2012

Made

Coming into force

THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND TECHNICAL SERVICES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the Motor Vehicle Races (Jersey) Law 1946, and on the application of the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club, orders as follows –

1 Interpretation

In this Order, “promoters” means the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club.

2 Use of courses in Schedule for races with motor vehicles

- (1) The promoters may use the courses described in the Schedule for races with motor vehicles on Saturday 7th July 2012 between 8.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m.
- (2) For that purpose, the promoters may close a course to traffic on the date and between the hours stated in paragraph (1) in relation to that course.

3 Application of other enactment

This Order is subject to the Road Racing (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 1959.

4 Citation

This Order may be cited as the Road Racing (Motor Vehicle Rally) (Jersey) Order 2012.

SCHEDULE

(Article 2)

COURSES

1	A course comprising the following public roads and portions of public roads in the Parish of St. Ouen – La Route des Havres from Les Havres Slipway to its junction with Le Mont du Vallet; thence along Le Mont du Vallet to its junction with La Route du Ouest; thence along La Route du Ouest and La Rue de la Mare to a point 50 metres south of the latter's junction with La Rue de la Devise.
2	A course comprising the following public roads and portions of public roads in the Parish of St. Ouen – La Route des Landes from its junction with Le Mont du Vallet to its junction with La Route de la Villaise; and La Rue de la Mare du Mont and the un-named road from their junctions with La Route des Landes to their junctions with La Route du Ouest.
