ROAD RACING (HILL CLIMBS AND SPRINTS) (No. 2) (JERSEY) ORDER 2012

THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND TECHNICAL SERVICES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the Motor Vehicle Races (Jersey) Law 1946, and on the application of the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club, orders as follows –

1 General provisions

- (1) This Order is subject to the Road Racing (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 1959.
- (2) The promoters, for the purposes of that Order and this Order, are the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club.

2 Use of Bouley Bay Hill course for hill climbs

- (1) During the periods specified in paragraph (3) the promoters may –
 - (a) use the Bouley Bay Hill course for hill climb races with motor vehicles, and for practices for those races; and
 - (b) for those purposes, close that course to traffic.
- (2) In paragraph (1) “Bouley Bay Hill course” means –
 - (a) the principal route, being the public road known as Bouley Bay Hill in the Parish of Trinity; and
 - (b) any part of a public road that meets the principal route, if the part is within 30 yards from the point at which that public road meets the principal route.
- (3) The periods referred to in paragraph (1) are between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on –
 - (a) 1st April 2013;
 - (b) 9th May 2013;
 - (c) 18th July 2013; and
 - (d) 26th August 2013.

3 Use of Five Mile Road course for sprint races

- (1) During the periods specified in paragraph (3) the promoters may –
 - (a) use the Five Mile Road course for sprint races with motor vehicles and for practices for those races; and
 - (b) for those purposes, close that course to traffic.
- (2) In this Article “Five Mile Road course” means –
 - (a) the principal route, being the road known as La Grande Route des Mielles (Route B.35) from its junction with Le Mont à la Brune to a point 75 yards south of La Carrière Quarry at La Pulente;
 - (b) any part of a public road that meets the principal route, if the part is within 30 yards from the point at which the road meets the principal route;
 - (c) the Gravel Car Park at La Pulente; and
 - (d) Le Braye Car Park.
- (3) The periods referred to in paragraph (1) are between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on –
 - (a) 23rd March 2013;
 - (b) 29th June 2013;
 - (c) 3rd August 2013; and
 - (d) 29th December 2013.
- (4) If bad visibility or other adverse conditions render it inadvisable to hold races using the Five Mile Road course during any of the periods specified in paragraph (3), the promoters may –
 - (a) postpone those races; and
 - (b) use that course for the postponed races and for practices for those races, and for that purpose close that course to traffic, between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on 7th September 2013.

4 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Road Racing (Hill Climbs and Sprints) (No. 2) (Jersey) Order 2012 and comes into force forthwith.
