ROAD RACING (MOTOR VEHICLE RALLY) (JERSEY) ORDER 2014

Made

Coming into force

THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND TECHNICAL SERVICES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the Motor Vehicle Races (Jersey) Law 1946, and on the application of the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club, orders as follows –

1 Interpretation

In this Order, “promoters” means the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club.

2 Use of courses in Schedule for races with motor vehicles

- (1) The promoters may use the public roads and portions of public roads in the parish of St. Ouen as described in the Schedule (the “courses”) for races with motor vehicles on Saturday 24th May 2014 between 8.00 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- (2) For that purpose, the promoters may close the courses to traffic on the date and between the hours mentioned in paragraph (1).

3 General provisions applying

This Order is subject to the Road Racing (General Provisions) Order 1959.

4 Citation

This Order may be cited as the Road Racing (Motor Vehicle Rally) (Jersey) Order 2014.

SCHEDULE

(Article 2(1))

COURSES

- 1** A course comprising –
La Route des Havres, from Les Havres slipway to its junction with Le Mont du Vallet; Le Mont du Vallet to its junction with La Route du Ouest; La Route du Ouest and La Rue de la Mare to a point 50 metres south of the latter's junction with La Rue de la Devise.
- 2** A course comprising –
La Route des Landes, from its junction with Le Mont du Vallet to its junction with La Rue de la Villaise; La Rue de la Mare du Mont and the un-named road from their junctions with La Route des Landes to their junctions with La Route du Ouest.
