Background

In 2019 the Minister for Infrastructure issued a permit for an electric vehicle car share initiative. The permit enabled electric vehicles to be parked in dedicated bays on street between each client use.

Two bays on street were allocated for an electric vehicle car share initiative on the Esplanade.

At the end of 2021 the Department for Infrastructure, Housing and Environment was advised by the company operating the electric vehicle car share initiative that the two on street parking bays situated on the Esplanade were no longer required.

Discussion

The two parking bays are no longer required for the electric vehicle car share. The permit for the electric vehicle car share can now be removed and parking bays can revert to standard on street parking bays.

Recommendations

The Minister is recommended to support this request and to instruct for the Amendment to the Road Traffic (St Helier) (Jersey) Order 1996 to be prepared for subsequent signing.

Reason(s) for Decision

To enable the two electric vehicle car share parking bays on Esplanade to revert back to standard on street parking bays.
