Introduction

The Minister for Infrastructure is asked to approve an Amendment to the Road Traffic (St. Mary) (Jersey) Order 2000 to make changes to traffic flow on La Ruette as requested by the Connétable of St. Mary.

Recommendation

Detail

The Connétable of St. Mary has requested a change to traffic flow on La Ruette. The is requested change shown in appendix 1.

The Connétable has reported there have been problems with 2 way traffic on La Ruette not being able to pass each other and has requested that the northern part of La Ruette be made one-way in a southerly direction. This will remove the possibility of vehicles travelling in opposite directions from conflicting with each other. It also allows the continuance of large vehicles travelling west on La Rue de Bel Air to be able to turn in a southerly direction. If this route is lost the alternative routing will be extremely difficult to manoeuvre through.

Policing of the area is carried out by the Parish of St. Mary through the Honorary Police. There is no additional resource implication for Infrastructure staff.

- Schedule 1 One-Way Traffic Routes:
 - Add a new entry after that for La Rue de la Vallée in the first column for "La Ruette" and in the second column "Southbound from the junction with La Rue de Bel Air to a point 46 yards north of the junction with La Rue de la Frontiere"
