SOCIAL SECURITY (OLD AGE PENSIONS AND SURVIVOR'S BENEFIT) (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) ORDER 2013

Made

Coming into force

THE MINISTER FOR SOCIAL SECURITY, in pursuance of Articles 13, 14, 25 and 51 of the Social Security (Jersey) Law 1974, orders as follows –

1 Interpretation

In this Order “principal Order” means the Social Security (Old Age Pensions and Survivor's Benefit) (Jersey) Order 2001.

2 Article 3 amended

In Article 3 of the principal Order for the words “paragraph 8 of Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Law” there shall be substituted the words “paragraph 3(1) of Part 1A of Schedule 1 to the Law”.

3 Article 4 amended

In Article 4 of the principal Order –

(a) in paragraph (1) for the words “paragraph (3) of this Article” there shall be substituted the words “paragraph (3) or (4) of this Article, as the case requires,”;

(b) for paragraph (3) there shall be substituted the following paragraphs –

“(3) Where a person is entitled to an old age pension under paragraph (1) or (2), the pension shall be payable at such weekly rate as bears the same relationship to the weekly rate in paragraph 3 of Part 1A of Schedule 1 to the Law that applies in the person's case as the person's life average contribution factor bears to a life average contribution factor of 1.00.

(4) Where a person is entitled to survivor's benefit under paragraph (1), the benefit shall be payable at such weekly rate as bears the same relationship to the appropriate weekly rate set out in paragraph 5 or 6 of Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Law as the person's

life average contribution factor bears to a life average contribution factor of 1.00.”.

4 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Social Security (Old Age Pensions and Survivor's Benefit) (Amendment) (Jersey) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 26th March 2013.
