Introduction

Further to proposition ($\underline{P.70/2021}$) lodged by Deputy Steven Ahier and the report ($\underline{R.41/2022}$) presented to the States Assembly by the Minister for Social Security; the Minister has decided to request legislative drafting to make changes to the Employment law to implement Parental Bereavement Leave in Jersey.

Recommendation

Detail (Decision and Reason for decision)

Following the adoption of the proposition described above and the reported presented to the Assembly by the Minister for Social Security; the Minister has decided to request legislative drafting in order to make a change to Employment Law. This decision carries out an existing decision of the States Assembly.

It is suggested that the additional rights to Parental Bereavement Leave will fall within Part 5A of the Employment Law (which deals with Parental Rights).

This is a new right, so will likely require an amending law.

No changes are being made to any other parental rights as part of this work.
