

# AMENDMENTS TO PUBLIC FINANCES MANUAL – FEBRUARY 2025

#### 1. Purpose of Report

To gain approval from the Minister for Treasury and Resources to amendments to the Public Finances Manual (PFM).

#### 2. Background

The Public Finances Manual was issued with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 by the Minister for Treasury and Resources. The Public Finances (Jersey) Law 2019 allows for amendments to be made by the Minister, and for the ability to make amendments to be delegated. Amendments delegated include those necessary to clarify requirements; those to ensure that the Manual is consistent with other published legislation, policies and procedures; and those which are required as part of an emergency as defined in Article 24 of the Public Finances (Jersey) Law 2019. All other amendments require Ministerial approval. The amendments proposed have been through the review process set in the Public Finances Manual for amendments which includes review by Accountable Officers and Heads of Finance Business Partnering as well as the Law Officers' Department. The proposed amendments are detailed in the attached table.

The Manual and all amendments must be issued to the States' Public Accounts Committee and made publicly available.

The amendments will be notified by letter to the Public Accounts Committee and will be effective from 1 February 2025.

## 4. Reason for Decision

Under Article 31 of the Public Finances (Jersey) Law 2019 the Minister is responsible for issuing a Public Finances Manual (PFM) and may amend the PFM. A notice of all such amendments must be presented to the Public Accounts Committee as soon as practicable after amendments are made. The PFM and all amendments must be made publicly available.

## 5. Resource Implications

The proposed amendments should improve financial governance and control within the States of Jersey and there are no direct additional financial or manpower implications related to the amendments to the PFM.
