## Survey Report & Analysis

The determination of the position of the northern boundary of the Field 1371

#### 1.0 Introduction

The northern boundary of Field 1371 is physically defined in the contract of sale as a bank with offset belonging to field 1372.

The bank has disappeared and the only physical separation that exists today is a line of trees.

It has been claimed that the line of trees was originally planted 12 feet to the north of the boundary.

#### 2.0 Aim

The aim of this analysis is to mathematically define the boundary and physically set it out on site.

### 3.0 Data used in the analysis

#### Survey Data

A precise survey of the west of the site was original undertaken in August 1997.

Further survey work was carried out in June 2001 in order to produce a complete digital survey of the whole site that was used as the basis of the subsequent analysis.

Both surveys were undertaken using electronic total station equipment giving a positional accuracy of +/-10mm.

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
