There is no temperature requirement for non-Drinking water samples, that we're aware of. So, if you could put the potatoes and milk in a solid box or ice chest, that will be fine. *Ziploc brand* bags could work to hold the potatoes and a glass bottle with a non-Teflon lined cap for the milk (well cushioned).

Do you know how long a shipment usually takes from you to the U.S. West Coast?
