Dear Kirsten and Ian,

I hope this note finds you both well. I am writing on behalf of the Reds to see if there is any update following the Council of Ministers meeting last week and to ask if you require any further information from us at all at this point?

We also wanted to let you know that since last our meeting, we have been actively talking to our sponsors preparing them for increased package costs for the 2024/25 season, which in general has been very positively received. We have also been asking for thoughts to help us in the short-term. As a result, we are already discussing a couple of out-sourcing ideas with them that could potentially yield 80-100k savings this season.

Additionally, with the help of [REDACTED] we have identified 4 new potential investors, as well as 3 which we have sourced ourselves.

Obviously, all of these ideas take time to finalise, but we are very focused on doing so.

We understand that Kirsten will be meeting [REDACTED] on September 27th, and hope that this will provide some further clarity and confirmation of GoJ support we have been discussing.

You will be aware that we will need to pay salaries this coming week and so it would be great to understand where we are on this subject.

We understand the additional work this is causing for all concerned and truly appreciate your time and interest.

Ministers

I am writing to you as I attended a meeting at Broad Street today, 27.9.23., between Deputy Morel, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] of GOJ, along with [REDACTED] at which [REDACTED] and I were informed of the Council of Ministers decision on 19.9.23. not to provide further financial assistance to Trading, as previously requested by Trading. There was suggestion that the Council of Ministers ("COM") decision may be reviewed if 150k could be found to meet immediate liabilities, within the subsequent 36 hours, however this was felt to be a remote possibility by [REDACTED] and myself.

[REDACTED] and I [REDACTED] of Jersey Reds (2022) Ltd, the investment company that has provided [REDACTED] of funding for Trading in the period since June 2022. Neither of us are directors of Trading.

I informed the directors of Trading, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], of the discussions outlined above, including the COM decision, immediately following the meeting with Deputy Morel. The directors of Trading were concerned why the COM decision on such an important matter was not immediately conveyed, despite multiple requests from Trading for clarification of the situation. They feel that the extended period of delay to learn of

the decision curtailed their ability to raise further short-term funds and has made the situation more traumatic than it may have been with immediate notification of the COM decision. Once they learned of the COM decision the directors sought legal advice from [REDACTED]. As a result of this advice Trading ceased operation and trading as a business as at 17.30 on 27.9.23. Announcements will be made to staff early on 28.9.23. and subsequently to other interested parties.

As you know I was [REDACTED] of Jersey Reds (2022) Ltd which is the company that provided 940k funding to Jersey Rugby Football Club (Trading) Ltd last season. It is Trading which is the business which has ceased operating, and I have never been a director of that business.

I also want to make it clear ahead of our meeting this Thursday that I am not part of or involved in any new fund raising or request for further government support.
