Supplementary Planning Guidance Managing change in historic buildings

18 February 2008

PURPOSE OF CONSULTATION

The purpose of this consultation is to seek comment on the provision of guidance in respect of change affecting historic buildings generally and, in particular, on;

- the provision of advice in respect of the management of change to protected buildings and sites
- the definition of the policy regime applicable to the protection of the historic built environment

BACKGROUND

The Minister for Planning and Environment has an obligation to protect sites, buildings, structures and places that have a special value or importance to the Island. Island Plan, Policy G13 sets the framework for the consideration of proposals for changes to historic buildings and the supplementary planning guidance published for consultation here provides further advice and guidance on specific aspects of change to historic buildings.

It is intended that this supplementary guidance and advice will provide a sound basis, particularly for those involved in the development process affecting historic buildings, for the preparation, consideration, assessment and determination of proposals and applications affecting the fabric and settings of the historic built environment, so that a common and easily available source may be referred to both as justification for works and in considering and determining applications.

The planning policy regime for the protection of the historic built environment has evolved over time and much of this previous policy and guidance is now obsolete. This consultation document seeks to set out the definitive framework of planning policy and guidance for the management of the historic built environment.
