Fair Nursery Places for all 3-4 Year Olds

We want to know your views



Introduction

Currently half of our 3-4 year olds receive a free nursery class place and half do not. We, at the Jersey Child Care Trust, believe that this is not a fair system and the Education and Home Affairs Scrutiny Panel also concluded this in their recent Early Years Report. One of the recommendations from the Scrutiny Panel was a consultation event with an independent chair to look at the options and provide the Minister for Education, Sport and Culture (ESC) with a workable solution.

We want to know what you think. How can early years education be accessed fairly by all 3-4 year olds?



We want to know if you think we should:

- Carry on building nursery classes at primary schools
- Develop a States and private sector partnership, allowing some free early years education for all children
- Reduce the number of hours available to each child so that all children could be offered a part time place in a nursery class
- Expect early years care to be funded by the States alone, parents alone or a combination of the two
