Section I - Guidance Notes

Licence overview

This application form is for a licence to disturb, take, handle and release protected wild birds for ringing purposes. It is a requirement of this project licence that the Applicant must hold a valid and up to date Channel Island Ringing Permit as accredited by the Channel Islands Bird Ringing Scheme.

It will be a condition of the licence, if granted, that the activities authorised by this licence are subject to the conditions that are attached to the Channel Island Ringing Permit. The licensed activities may only be undertaken by the Licence holder.

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Application definitions

Applicant

The Applicant is the named individual who is applying for the licence and who would become the licence holder if the licence is granted.

Assistants may be employed to act under this licence provided that they are supervised by the Applicant at all times.

Designated Sites

Areas of Special Protection are areas of land that are designated under the Wildlife (Jersey) Law 2021 to provide legal protection for certain wild animals, birds or plants from disturbance or harm during critical phases of their life cycle. Restrictions on access to and on activities within an Area of Special Protection at certain times may apply.

Natural Sites of Special Interest (SSIs) are places that are designated under the <u>Planning and Building (Jersey) Law 2002 (jerseylaw.je)</u> because of their special zoological, ecological, botanical or geological interest.
