What you need:

Pond Tank



Clear plastic container



Plastic toy fish



Floatable object -Eg. Styrofoam ball or a cork



String

Pollutants



Tissue paper



Straw



Chocolate Wrapper



Grass clippings or leaves



Cooking oil



Soil or gravel






What to do:



Fill the clear plastic container ³/₄ full of water.



Using some string, attach the plastic toy fish to the floatable object and place in the container. The fish should be suspended in the middle of the water.



Drop the different types of 'pollutants', one by one, into the water.
