

- Magazines
- Books

- White printing or computer paper
- Letters
- Shredded paper
- · Junk mail and flyers
- Envelopes (including those with a window)
- Greeting cards (remove batteries from musical cards)



- Paper stained with foodstuffs, grease, paint or dirt
- Greaseproof or baking paper
- Kids paintings
- Hygiene and sanitary products (for example, nappies, wet wipes, sanitary towels, used paper towels, cotton wool and make up pads)
- Non-paper gift wrap or bags (for example, foil-based gift wrapping, crisp or sweet packets or wrappers)
- Wrapping paper and gift wrap
- Wallpaper and decoration paper
- Brown paper (this can be recycled with cardboard)
- Tissues and tissue paper









# NOT IN THE BIN!



**DO NOT** put these items in the general rubbish

- Glass
- Batteries
- Electricals
- Metals
- Lightbulbs
- Ceramics

### Metal Packaging

- Drinks cans, food tins (put tin lids inside the tin)
- Biscuit and chocolate tins and their lids
- Aerosols (remove plastic caps and put with your general refuse)
- Metal lids, for example jam jar lids
- Aluminium foil (clean)
- Aluminium foil and take-away trays (clean)
- Aluminium tubes, for example tomato puree (remove plastic caps)



- Laminated foil, for example cat food and coffee pouches that spring back when you scrunch them
- Crisp and sweet packets or wrappers
- Metal containers for chemicals, for example white spirits, paints or engine oils
- General kitchen ware for example cutlery, pots and pans
- Other metal items for example kettles, irons, pipes, large household appliances




# RECYCLE Cardboard
