Covid-19 - Offences for failure to display motor insurance discs Revocation of Attorney General's Guidance dated 17 April 2020

On 17 April 2020, Attorney General's Guidance was issued to Centeniers in relation to offences contrary to Article 16(1), (2) or (3) of the Motor Traffic (Third-Party Insurance) Jersey Law 1948 (the "**Law**"). This statement should be read in conjunction with the Guidance issued on 17 April 2020:

I have been informed by the Association of British Insurers that insurers are now able to print windscreen insurance discs and issue them to Jersey residents in accordance with Article 6 of the Law.

I am, therefore, giving members of the public 14 days' notice from the date of this statement, that my Guidance of 17 April 2020 will be revoked so that they can arrange for an insurance disk to be displayed if they have not already done so. From 00:01 on **27 August 2020** any person may be charged with an offence contrary to Article 16 (1), (2) or (3) of the Law for failure to display an insurance disc.
