Your comments: The coastline is one of Jersey's defining characteristics. When natural erosion occurs, steps are taken to protect a threatened area. It is therefore illogical to facilitate man-made erosion, particularly given the presumption against development in the countryside and along the headland.

The original consent was for holiday accommodation, that is for large numbers of people to enjoy the area on a temporary basis in common with others, none of whom would accrue rights of permanent occupation.

Even before population pressures caused worries about the slipstream effect on the environment and services of more building, there was no understanding that individuals would reside permanently in this location. Now it is accepted that there is a duty to protect Jersey's naturally-occurring heritage as well as its culture and historic buildings.

For all these reasons, I think that this application should be refused.
