I wish to register my objection to the above application. In my view there should be no development on this land whatsoever and it should be returned to its natural state.

My reasons are as follows:

1. It is a unique site in the Island and is already in a protected area.
2. Although there has been development on it with the holiday camp, this should be disregarded given the particular uniqueness of the site.
3. It is accepted that the proposed number of houses has been reduced from previous applications. However, any residential development will irrevocably alter the natural beauty of this coastal site.
4. There will be an increase to the traffic in the area, and an increase in domestic animals which may have a detrimental effect on the already depleted vegetation in the cliffs below the site.
5. Both visitors and future generations of Islanders will benefit from the site being returned to its natural state. There is no equivalent benefit accruing to the construction of 28 houses.
