




- 1. Existing 'Soft' clinical functions (Gwyneth Huelin).
- 2. Existing Non-Clinical functions (Peter Crill House and Link Block).
- 3. Essential facility boiler house
- 4. Essential support facilities (pathology, pharmacy, mortuary)
- 5. Essential accommodation Inpatients, Maternity
- 6. Protected heritage features (Granite Block & Gatehouse)
- 7. Essential accommodation theatres, emergency, inpatients
- 8. Separate New Support Facility for Non-Clinical Functions
- 9. Maximised Site Footprint to achieve Optimal Clinical Adjacencies

The site has been arranged to ensure essential services remain operational during construction. Splitting non-clinical support functions into a separate Support Facility allows the main hospital to maximise the footprint for optimal clinical adjacencies and the introduction of courtyards and critical massing considerations




Site Footprint extruded to indicate minimum volume of accommodation (without application of massing and courtyard considerations)



Site Footprint extruded as a volume with application of height and massing considerations and introduction of courtyards


