- The work detailed on this form may be commenced as soon as the application has been accepted by the department;
- No fee is payable, to the extent that this application relates to the removal of a fossil fuel boiler and its replacement with a non-fossil fuel alternative.
- Every application must include 1 copy of a location map, which is an authorised direct copy of the current 1:2500 scale map of the island and the appropriate fee for the works. The fees payable for applications are set out in the department's fee schedule which can be downloaded from the States of Jersey website, www.gov.je, or collected from the department. Cheques should be made payable to the 'Treasurer of the States'.
