ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

PLANNING AND BUILDING (JERSEY) LAW 2002

- This Notice is issued pursuant to the powers conferred under Article 40 of the Planning and Building (Jersey) Law 2002, (Revised: 1st January 2016), because it appears that a breach of development controls has occurred at the land stated below. Article 5 of the above Law defines the meaning of development and Article 7 of that Law states that land shall not be developed without planning permission.
- 2. This Notice relates to land at: Kara Mia, La Rue de la Corbiere, St. Brelade, JE3 8HN, shown edged by a bold black line on the attached location plan marked A.
- 3. a) The Breach of Development Controls: Without planning permission development has taken place on the land in your ownership, specifically:-
 - The construction of a Poly tunnel of 3.2m in height and 90 square meters in floor area to the southern garden of the property, Kara Mia, shown edged by black hatching on the attached plan <u>marked</u> **B**.

The above mentioned works are considered to represent building, engineering or other operations and do not benefit from any exemption from requiring planning permission as may be conferred by the Planning and Building (General Development) (Jersey) Order, 2011 (Revised - 01.01.17).

b) You are hereby required to: Remove the unauthorised development described in a) above.

- **4. Period of compliance:** Within two calendar months from the issue date of this Notice.
- 5. What will happen if this Notice is not complied with: If you fail to comply with this Notice, you may be liable to prosecution under the appropriate Article of the Planning and Building (Jersey) Law 2002, (Revised: 1st January 2016), for developing land without the benefit of planning permission as well as failing to comply with an Enforcement Notice.



6. Your rights of appeal: In accordance with Article 109 of the above Law, you may appeal against the Notice, in writing to the Greffier no later than the end of the period of 28 days beginning with the date of issue of the Notice. The date of the issue of the Notice shall be taken as the date stated below.
