

St Mary's 20mph Trial Consultation Report

The TTS Public Consultation on the 20mph trial through St Mary's Village received 13 responses. All responses were from residents of the area, or from parishioners of St Mary.



The majority of respondents (77%) agreed that the proposed trial 20mph zone would be beneficial to the parish, whilst a minority (23%) suggested that the trial was unnecessary and that other factors should be considered to control speed before reducing speed limits.



One repeated view was that the current traffic calming measures have in fact worsened the situation. Several comments were also received regarding the extension of the zone to the parish boundary. 15% of respondents suggested that policing was crucial to ensure the speed limits would be enforced. Those who disagreed suggested that there were more important factors, such as upkeep of road surfaces and the provision of pavements.

Summary:

- 77% agreed with the trial; 23% disagreed.
- There was a general consensus that the traffic calming measures should be removed owing to their ineffectiveness.
- Enforcement, suggestions of other measures needed and the view that other changes should be made before lowering speed limits were amongst the other concerns raised.
