

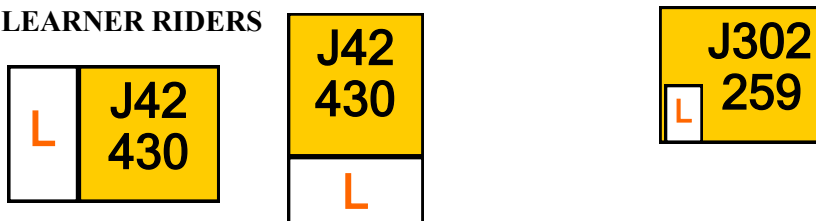


**DIMENSIONS OF MOTORCYCLE / MOPED REGISTRATION MARKS**

Character Height	64mm
Character Width	44mm
Character Stroke	10mm
Space between characters	10mm
Top & bottom margin	11mm
Side margin (minimum)	11mm
Space between top & bottom lines	13mm

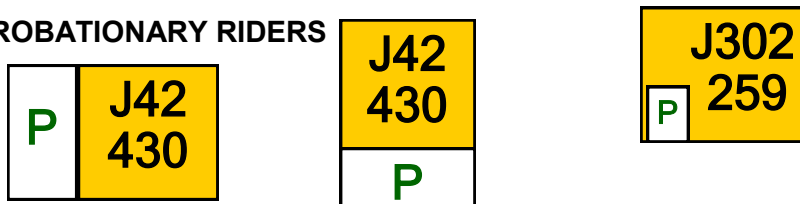
The J or JSY must be on the upper line, the numerals indicating hundreds, tens and units must be on the lower line and any other numerals must be on the upper line.

**NOTE: LEARNER RIDERS**



An integral L plate must be displayed. A separate L Plate as used for other Motor vehicles is not permitted.

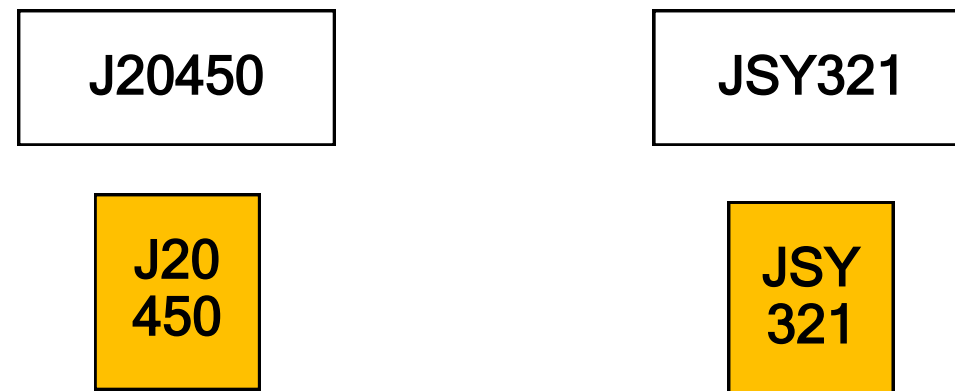
**NOTE: PROBATIONARY RIDERS**



A P plate must be displayed for a continuous period of 12 months from the date of passing the motorcycle driving test.

## GENERAL

### Display of Registration Marks From 01/01/2024:

For vehicles registered and new number plates fixed on or after 01/01/2024 the number plate must comply with the requirements of British Standards Specification **BSAU145e** and **MUST** be permanently marked with:

- BSAU145e standard mark.
- Name of supplier or manufacturer of the parts used to assemble the plate.
- Name and postcode of the supplying outlet of the assembled plate.
- Additional forms of advertising can only be displayed outside of the registration plate (i.e. a 'lipped' style plate).

Additionally:

- (a) The Registration Mark must be displayed on a flat unbroken plate.
- (b) A plate must be displayed vertically on both the front and the rear of the vehicle (motorcycles display **ONLY** on the rear of the vehicle).
- (c) The rear plate must be illuminated at night.
- (d) The number plate must be kept clean and efficient.

### Black Plate With White, Silver or Light Grey Digits:

May only be displayed on vehicles **manufactured prior to 1st January 1976** and are not required to comply with the BSAU145e standard.

### Trailers:

A duplicate of the registration mark of the drawing vehicle must be displayed on a registration plate on the rear of the trailer ("**trailers**" include a boat trailer, generator etc.)

Trailers registered under the Road Traffic (Registration of Trailers—Vienna Convention) (Jersey) Order 2018 are required to display their own registration mark, in addition to the duplicate registration mark of the drawing vehicle.

**Agricultural Trailers:** The same rules as above apply.

### Green Marker

A zero emission vehicle may display a green background (or 'flash') to the left of a registration mark. Hybrid vehicles are not zero emission and therefore cannot display the green marker.

### Non-Compliance -Offences & Penalties:

A person who fails to comply with the prescribed requirements relating to the display of registration marks shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £1,000.

If any person uses a Registration Mark assigned to a particular vehicle on any other vehicle shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £10,000 or up to six months imprisonment.

**NOTE: You can choose to display either Format A or Format B plates on the front or the rear of your vehicle.**

On a Format B plate the J or JSY must be on the upper line, the numerals indicating hundreds tens and units must be on the lower line and any other numerals must be on the upper line.

## DIMENSIONS OF REGISTRATION MARKS (NOT Motor Cycles / Mopeds)

### Characters

Height	79mm
Width (except the figure 1 or letter I)	50mm
Stroke	14mm
Space between characters	11mm
All side margins (minimum)	11mm
Space between top & bottom lines if format B	19mm

The characters shall be in the prescribed font and the plate shall comply with the requirements of British Standard Specification No **BSAU145e**
